

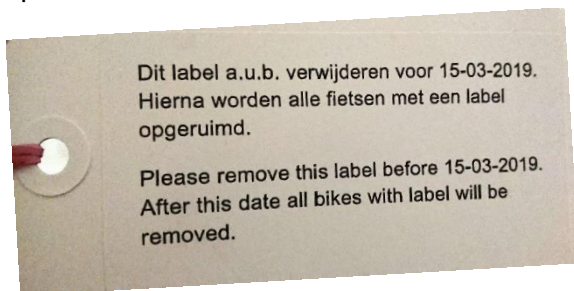

## Bicycle shed clear-out

All bicycles in the public bicycle shed on the ground floor have been labelled in the past month:



All bicycles from which the label has not been taken off will be removed next Saturday, 16th March. Owners missing their bicycles can address the Board on this issue no later than one month after this date.

## Problems with containers

Residents regularly leave things in a container or in the container compartment that do not belong there.



Consequently, Cure, our Refuse Service leaves such a (full) container unemptied.

Material placed next to the containers (sometimes even a complete couch) is also left in the compartment and will not be removed.



Consequently, we have to clear these things ourselves or must have them cleared, with all the attendant extra cost.

The Board therefore urgently requests all residents to deposit only their garbage in properly tied-up bags in the green containers and only paper or cardboard (boxes flattened) in the blue containers. All other materials should be taken to the milieustraat (municipal dumpsite) at Gabriël Metsulaan. Glass and plastics should be separately deposited in respective containers at 't College and Begijnhof. Such containers can also be found in the vicinity of supermarkets.
